Policy Review: The Library Director and Trustees reviewed Personnel policy on pages 46-48 of the Greene Public Library Policy Manual. Motion by Andrea Ramker, second by Kathi Stuntz to add the afternoon of Christmas Eve as a paid holiday per City of Greene adopted policy. Roll call, all ayes. Motion carried.

Trustee Training: The Library board discussed 3 recent legislative proposals: SF 238/HF 28 that modifies provisions related to public libraries that are eligible to receive state assistance under the enrich Iowa program; SF 347/HF 558 - An Act prohibiting certain materials in public libraries in counties and cities, authorizing civil actions, and providing civil penalties; SF 235/HF 274 - An Act relating to obscenity exemptions for public libraries and educational institutions. The Greene Library Board of Trustees oppose these legislative proposals as presented.
